2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

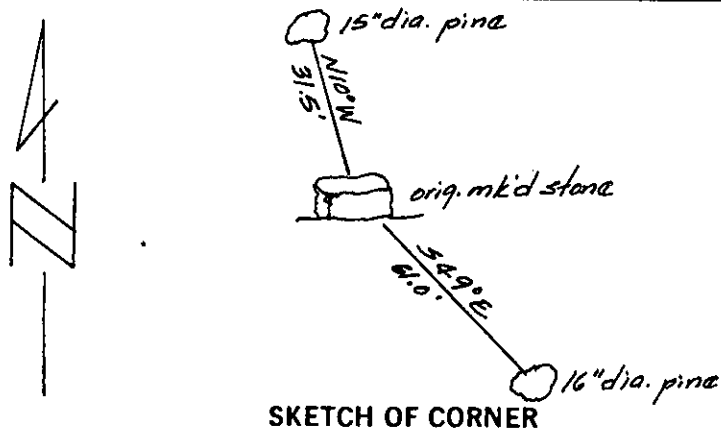

EVIDENCE FOUND: 12 x 7 inch stone marked 7 HES 935, SW face
 16" Pine with blaze bears S.49°E., 61.0 feet distance with K-tag
 15" Pine with blaze bears N.10°W., 31.5 feet with K-tag

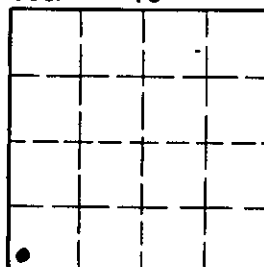
