NORTH 1/16 CORNER ON WEST LINE OF SEC. 16 TWP. 31 N., R. 33 W. M. P. M.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

North 1/16 Corner on West line was not set at time of original survey.
N 1/4 Corner of subject Section is standard brass cap monument with witnesses - set by B.L.M.
401.45' East and 28.9' North of mid-point between NW and NE Corners
West 1/4 Corner of subject Sec. not found but position confirmed by measurement and by illegible remains of bearing trees in reported locations
North 1/4 Corner reported at 40.12 chains - a post with a marked stone 12" in ground - Pits 18X18X12 east and west 5 1/2 feet - mound of earth 3' base 1 1/2' high around post.
No bearing trees. Now a brass cap set by B.L.M. In position shown on sketch on reverse.
NW Corner of subject Section is standard brass cap monument with witnesses - set by B.L.M.

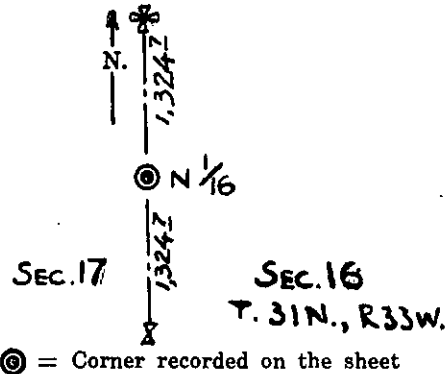
