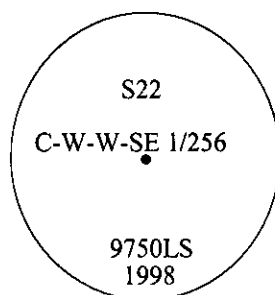


# CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

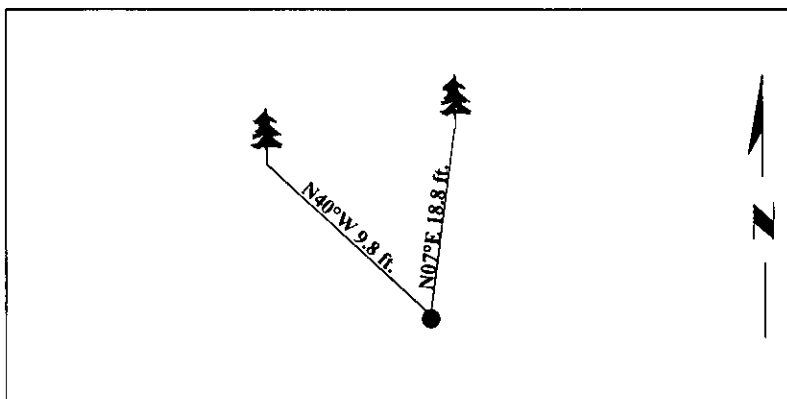


Established two bearing trees:

- A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears N07°E, 18.8 ft. dist., mkd. "C W W SE 1/256 S22 BT".
- A hemlock, 11 ins. diam., bears N40°W, 9.8 ft. dist., mkd. "C W W SE 1/256 S22 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
