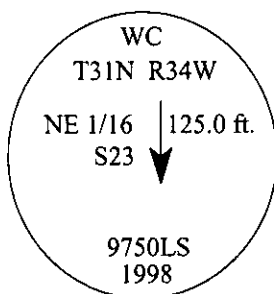


CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

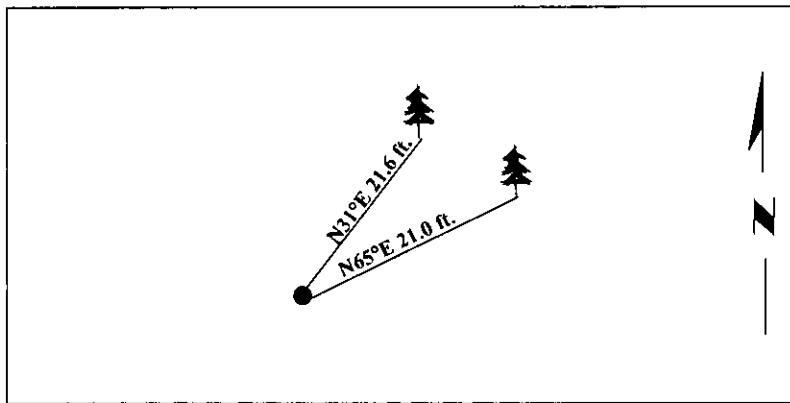


Established two bearing trees:

- A cedar, 16 ins. diam., bears N31°E, 21.6 ft. dist., mkd. "X" on a snow blaze "BT"
- A cedar, 16 ins. diam., bears N65°E, 21.0 ft. dist., mkd. "WC NE 1/16 S23 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
