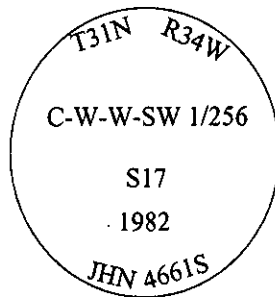


CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner C-W-W-SW 1/256 Sec. 17 T. 31N R. 34W P.M., MT Lincoln County

- I. 1982 Certified Corner Recordation by Jack H. Ninneman, 4661S: This corner was not previously set. Set a 3" x 30" aluminum capped monument marked as shown below.



from which:

- A 7" Cedar, bears N18°W, 14.0 feet, scribed "C-W-W-SW 1/256 S17 BT" and posted.
- A 7" Cedar, bears S78°W, 15.5 feet, scribed "C-W-W-SW 1/256 S17 BT" and posted.
- A location poster on a 5" Cedar, bearing S72°W, 9.2 feet.

Painted monument and accessories with bright red paint.

- II. Found a 3 in. diam. aluminum capped monument, flush with the ground, mkd. as shown and witnessed by the original bearing trees and location tree.

from which:

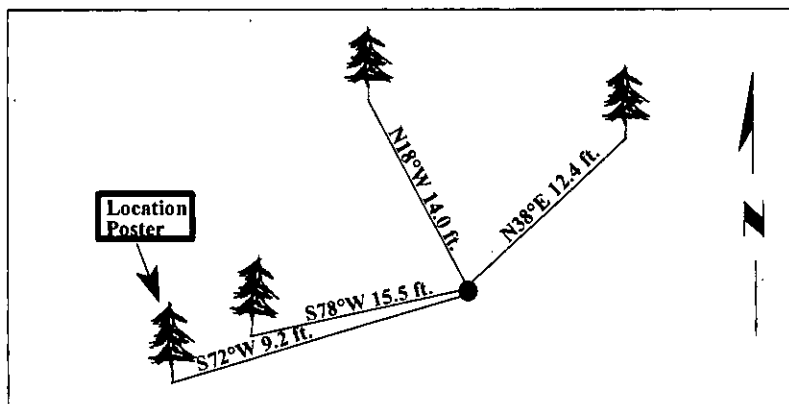
- A location poster on a 7 in. diam. cedar, bearing S72°W, 9.2 ft. dist. of the monument.
- A tilted cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears S78°W, 15.5 ft. dist., with visible scribe.
- A cedar, 7 ins. diam., bears N18°W, 14.0 ft. dist., with visible scribe.

- III. Established one new bearing tree:

- A hemlock, 17 ins. diam., bearing N38°E, 12.4 ft. dist., mkd. "C-W-W-SW S17 BT".

Painted red bands around the bearing tree and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.

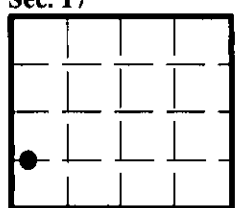
