

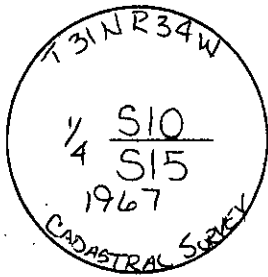
INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

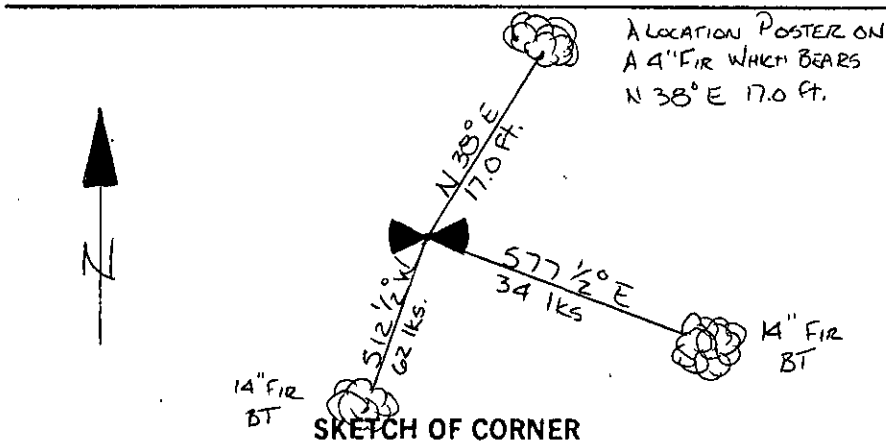
**CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

Corner N 1/4 Corner Sec. 15 T. 31N R. 34W P.M.M. Lincoln County

1. 40.04 chains: Set a limestone, 14 X 8 X 6 inches, 10 inches in the ground, for 1/4 Section corner, marked 1/4 on N. face; from which,
  - A Fir, 14 inches diameter, bears S.42°45'W., 80 links distance, marked 1/4S15B.T.
  - A Pine, 24 inches diameter, bears N.60°W., 32 links distance, marked 1/4S10B.T.
2. Found: B.L.M. Standard brass capped monument marked as shown below from which,
  - A 14" Fir bears S.77 1/2°E 34 links. Scribing overgrown. Posted.
  - A 14" Fir bears S.12 1/2°W 62 links. Scribing overgrown. Posted.
  - A location poster on a 4" Fir bears N.38°E 17.0 feet.
  - Painted monument and accessories with bright red paint.



Found B.L.M. standard brass capped monument marked as shown.
