A Fir 5 ins. dia. bears S.26°W., 10 lks. dist. marked T31N., R.34W., S.34 B.T.

AFir 7 ins. dia. bears N.44°30'W., 29 lks. dist. marked T31N.,R34W., S.27 B.T.

Found 1968 B.L.M. Bhass Cap. II.

Found a 20" Pine, bears N.49°30'E. @ 42.2 ft., blaze visible.


Found a 22" Fir, bears S.70°30'E., @ 34.2 ft., grown over blaze.
