
## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

Corner 1/4 Sec. 14&23 T. 31N R. 34W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1903 G.L.O. Original Record by Allen B. Benedict: Set a granite stone, 12x10x8 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., mkd. "1/4" on the N. face. Established two bearing trees.

1966-68 B.L.M. Remonumentation Record by Woodrow E. Damm et. al: The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 14&23, monumented with a granite stone, 12x10x8 ins., firmly set, mkd. "1/4" on the N. face, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with a brass cap mkd. as shown.



Established one new bearing tree and burined the original stone alongside the iron post.

1982 Certified Corner Recordation by J. H. Ninneman, 4661S: Found a B.L.M. brass capped monument mkd. as shown above. Found one original and the B.L.M. bearing tree. Painted accessories red.

II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, protruding 6 ins. above the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. B.L.M. brass cap mkd. as shown above.

from which:

A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears N35°W, 3.7 ft. dist., with visible scribe. (GLO-record-N45°30'W)

III. Established one bearing tree:

A pine, 25 ins. diam., bears S08°W, 75.5 ft. dist., mkd. "1/4 S23 BT".

Painted red bands around the bearing tree and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
