

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

At $\frac{1}{4}$ corner common to S. 5 & 6, T33N, R26W, P.M.M., Lincoln County, Mont., we find; Quartzite rock 10" X 12" X 6" above ground, marked " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on west face, set firmly (Record: Quartzite stone 14 X 12 X 8 ins. - - -) from which: A 14" down dead fir the root crown of which bears S 68° E, 23 links, scribing plain (Record: 9" fir S 67° E, 23 links) & a down 18" fir, dead, the root crown of which bears S 15° W, 70 links (Record: A fir 14" bears S 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W, 70 links).

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

To perpetuate this corner we piled a large ring of rocks around the original rock and create two new reference monument trees which bear from the corner as follows: A 10" fir bears S 24° W, 41 links dist. and a 9" fir bears N 23° W, 27 links dist., both double blazed and scribed "RM". We posted BT and location posters. Date of work: 5/23/66

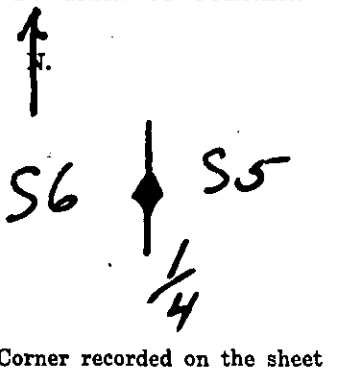
