

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner West 1/4 Section 6 only T. 33N R. 26W P.M.M. Lincoln County

GLO Record: Set limestone 15"X8"X6", 10" in the ground, mkd. "1/4" on W. face, from which:
 6" Spruce, mkd. "1/4 S6 BT" bears S15°45'E 33 lks.
 18" Tamarack, mkd. "1/4 S1 BT" bears S26°W 42 lks.

Found: Limestone 12"X5"X6", mkd. "1/4" on West face, firmly set in the ground, from which:
 6" diam. dead spruce lying face down, scribing visible uprooted base of tree bears S16°E 22'.
 Tamarack in SW quadrant is gone.

New Monumentation: At the location mkd. by the stone, I set a 2" diam. aluminum monument with 3" cap mkd. as shown below; buried stone alongside monument, and raised mound of stone around cap.
 15" Spruce scribed "W 1/4 S6 BT" bears N68°E 14.73
 12" Spruce scribed "W 1/4 S6 BT" bears S65°E 10.97

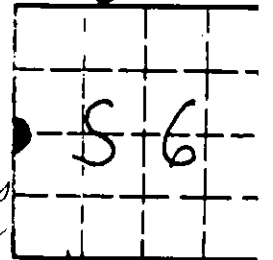
