

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

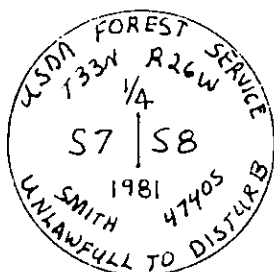
1/4 Corner Common to Sections 7E8 T. 33N R. 26W P.M.M. Lincoln County

GLO Record: Set quartzite stone 18X10X6 ins. 12" in the ground
mkd. "1/4" on W. face, from which:
A 4" pine mkd. "1/4 S 7 BT" bears N10°W 14 lks.
A 5" tamarack mkd. "1/4 S 8 BT" bears N57 1/2°E 8 lks.

Found: Stone as described by GLO, firmly set, from which:

14" Tamarack, face overgrown, bears N57°E 6.3'
10" Pine, face overgrown, bears N10°W 9.5'
I did not consider it necessary to open either of the trees to prove the corner.

New Monumentation: At the location mkd. by the stone, I set a 2" diam. aluminum monument with 3" cap stamped as shown below. Because both bearing trees are alive and healthy, I did not mark any other trees. Buried original stone alongside monument.

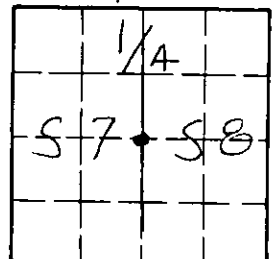
