 2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
 3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
 4. Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
 5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
 6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner: 1/4 Corner To Sections 20 & 21 T. 33N R. 26W P.M.M. Lincoln County

GLO Record: Set limestone, 15 X 10 X 4 ins., 10" in the ground, mkd. "1/4" on West face, from which:

A 5" Tamarack mkd. "1/4 S 21 BT" bears N 49 1/2° E 54 1/2 ks.

A 6" Pine mkd. "1/4 S 20 BT" bears S 70 1/2° W 67 1/2 ks

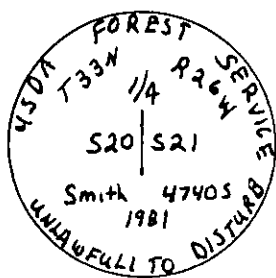
Found: Stone per record, slightly tipped, base appears to be in original position

14" Tamarack with blaze overgrown bears N 49° E 37.10 feet

12" pine with blaze overgrown bears S 71° W 43.90 feet

It was not deemed necessary to open the bearing trees to prove the corner

New Monumentation: At the position marked by the stone's base, I set a standard 2" diameter aluminum monument with 3" cap stamped as shown below. I buried the stone alongside the new monument and raised a mound of rock around the corner. Because both bearing trees are alive and healthy, no additional trees were scribed for this corner.
