I. 1929 GLO Record: Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the ½ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

from which,

A lodgepole pine, 8 ins. in diam., bears S. 21^{0} 15' E., 34 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 B T.

A fir, 12 ins. in diam., bears N. 26° 30' W., 31 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 4 B T.


II. I found a GLO brass cap in stone pile, marked as shown, and from which:

A 10" lodgepole pine bears S20 E, 22.2 ft., scribing visible.

A 12 " stump bears N260W, 20.8 ft., scribing visible.

A 10" lodgepole pine bears N35°E, 31.0 ft., which I scribe "1 S 4 BT."

III. I paint red bands around the BT's and paint the blazes and attach USFS signs 54-3 & 54-9 to each BT. I set USFS steel post with decal 54-9 attached alongside found monument.
