

Placed a rock collar around monument Bury the original stone alongside the new monument.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears 877° E, 45.5 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S30 BT.

Set a guard post, with a "Survey Marker" decal attached, 4.7 ft. E. from the corner.

Painted a red band around each bearing tree and attached "Land Survey Monument" and "Bearing Tree" signs where needed.
