

1911 original G.L.O. record by William C. Perkins: Set a stone monument and mkd. two bearing trees.

1976 B.L.M. remonumentation record by Joseph E. French: "The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 30, monumented with a limestone, $14 \times 10 \times 8$ ins., firmly set 10 ins. in the ground, mkd. 1/4on the W. face, and witnessed by the original bearing trees:

A fir. 14 ins. diam., bears $N68^{\circ}$ E, 24 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S29 BT. A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N4 W, 27 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S30 BT.

At the corner point; set an iron post, 30 ins. long. 2 1/2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground, to bedrock and in a supporting mound of stone, 4 ft. diam., to top, with brass cap mkd.



Bury the original stone alongside the iron post."

- II. Found an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 16 ins. out of the ground with attached 3 1/4 ins. diam., B.L.M. brass cap marked as shown above, from which
 - A fir snag, 13 ins. diam., bears $N68^{\circ}E$, 15.8 ft. (24 lks.) dist., mkd. 29 BT. A fir snag, 14 ins. diam., bears N4 $^{\circ}$ W, 17.8 ft. (27 lks.) dist., mkd. 30 BT.
- III. Established two new bearing trees:

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears $N16^{\circ}E$, 28.5 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 s29 BT. A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears $N50^{\circ}W$, 50.7 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 s30 BT.

Painted a red band around each bearing tree and attached "Land Survey Monument" and "Bearing Tree" signs where needed.

Set a guard post, with "Survey Marker" decal attached, 3 ft. N. from corner.
