- Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
- 2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated
- escription of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
- 4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
- 5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Land Surveyor registered in the State of Montana 6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

1976 B.L.M. remonumentation record by Joseph E. French: "The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a trachyte stone, $24 \times 11 \times 8$ ins., firmly set 18 ins. in the ground. mkd. 1 notch on the S. and 5 notches on the N. edges, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees:

A fir stump, 20 ins. diam., bears N41 1/2 E. 63 lks. dist., with the bottom portion of a blaze visible. A fir stump, 20 ins. diam., bears S38 1/2 E, 53 lks. dist., with an overgrown blaze.

A stump hole, bears S61 W, 48 lks. dist., with a fir, 16 ins. diam., mkd. T32N R29W S36 BT, lying

At the corner point; set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from wich new bearing trees:

- A larch, 8 ins. diam., bears N46 1/2°E, 53 lks. dist., mkd. T32N R28W S30 BT. A larch, 7 ins. diam., bears S55 1/2°E, 40 lks. dist., mkd. T32N R28W S31 BT.
- A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears 833° W, 33 lks. dist., mkd. T32N R29W S36 BT. A larch, 6 ins. diam., bears N73 $^{\circ}$ W, 24 lks. dist., mkd. T32N R29W S25 BT.

Bury the original stone alongside and raise a flat mound of stone, 2 ft. diam., around the iron post."

- II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 8 ins. out of the ground with attached 3 1/4 ins. diam. B.L.M. brass cap mkd. as shown above, from which

 - A stump, bears N39 W, 42.8 ft. (65 lks.) dist. (G.L.O. rcd.)

 A stump, bears N41 E. 41.6 ft. (63 lks.) dist., partial scribe visible. (G.L.O. rcd.)

 A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears N32 E, 24.2 ft. dist., healed face (no rcd.)


 A larch, 11 ins. diam., bears N47 E, 34.8 ft. (53 lks.) dist., healed face (B.L.M. rcd.)

 - A stump and log, bears S38 E, 35.0 ft. (53 lks.) dist. (G.L.O. rcd.)

 A larch, 8 ins. diam., bears S56 E, 26.7 ft. (40 lks.) dist., healed face (B.L.M. rcd.)

 A larch, 12 ins. diam., bears S61 E, 41.7 ft. dist., healed face (no rcd.)

 - A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears 833°_{M} W, 22.0 ft. (33 lks.) dist., healed face (B.L.M. rcd.)
 - A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears \$49 W, 15.4 ft. dist., healed face (no rcd.)
 - A downed tree, bears 860° W, 31.3 ft. (47 lks.) dist., visible scribe "2" (G.L.O. rcd.) A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears 860° W, 860° W, 860
- III. Painted a red band around each bearing tree and attached "Land Survey Monument" and "Bearing Tree" signs where needed. Set a guard post, with a "Survey Marker" decal attached, 3 ft. S. from corner. Magnetic Declination: East, 19
