A fir, 12 ins. in diam., bears  $N23^{\circ}W$ , 36 lks. dist., marked T32N R28W S30 BT." 1967 recordation by Ira M. Tillotson (Reg. No. 858 ES): "We double blaze a 7" pine which bears \$70 W. 29.0 feet from the original monument, scribed RM." II. 
Established one new bearing tree:
