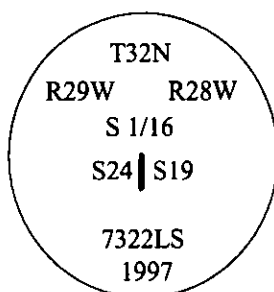


CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

- III. Set by survey, an aluminum rod, 30 ins. long, 3/4 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap mkd. as shown below:

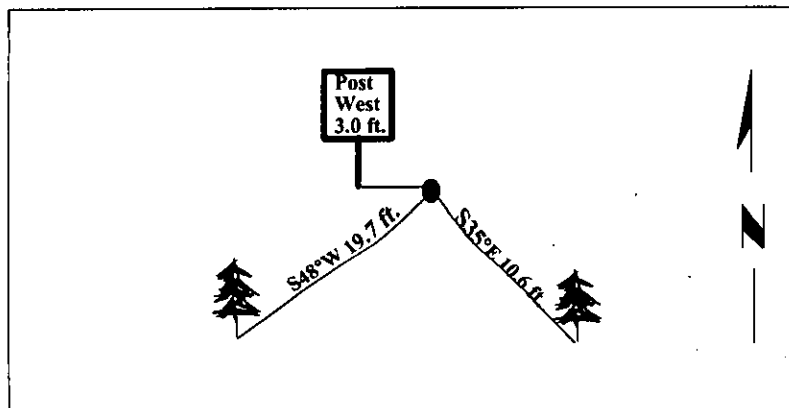


Established two bearing trees:

- A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S35°E, 10.6 ft. dist., mkd. "S 1/16 S19 BT".
- A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S48°W, 19.7 ft. dist., mkd. "S 1/16 S24 BT".

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post, West, 3.0 ft. dist. with Property Boundary and Land Survey Monument decals attached.
Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
