## DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found (record-set) a trachite stone, 27"x12"x12", 20" in ground, marked ¼ on W face.

From which: A tamarack (alive) 24" diameter, bears N414°E, 101 links distance,

marked 1/4 S28 BT. (REC.)

A tamarack (stump), 28" diameter, bears N17½0W, 93 links distance,

marked ¼ S29 BT. (REC)


Found stone in place and both BT's at record bearing and distance. Set pipe at corner point.

## DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe, 30" long, 18" in ground to solid bedrock, with brass cap marked. Buried original stone alongside iron pipe and raised a mound of stone, 3½' base to top of cap.

New BT: A pine, 8" diameter, bears N180W, 76 links distance, marked ¼ S29 BT.


