1940 - At a point N0° 20'W, 0.42 chains (27.72 feet) from the East 1/4 corner of Section 8, I set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1 inch in diameter, 28 inches in the ground, for the 1/2 comer to Section 9 only, with a brass cap, from which:

A 6" pine bears N58° E, 31 links (20.46'), marked "1/4 S9 BT" A 4" balsam bears S40° E, 16 links (10.56'), marked "1/4 S9 BT"

FOUND:

Found the 1940 brass cap, 18" out of the ground and bent to the north at a 45° angle and the monument was not oriented correctly.

A pine stump bears N55 °E, 19.8 feet, with no visible scribing.


SET:

I straightened the monument and oriented it correctly accepting said position as the 1/2 corner to Section 9. Piled a mound of stones around the corner from which I scribed 2 new bearing trees:

An 8" spruce bears S65° E, 19.9 feet, marked "1/4 S9 BT" A 7" fir bears N59°30'E, 9.1 feet, marked "1/4 S9 BT"

I placed a 6 foot steel post with Land Survey Monument decal 1 foot north of the corner.

The blazes and scribing on the new bearing trees were painted red and bearing tree tags were attached.
