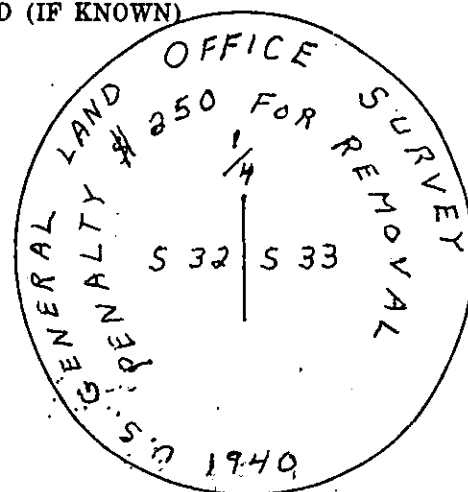


CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found original stone firmly set, 16x8x6 inches, 10 inches in ground with $\frac{1}{4}$ on West face. (record same) Found a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe firmly set alongside the original stone, with brass cap marked, from which: a 25 inch larch bears, N. $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 86 links, scribing visible 32, the remaining portion of scribing overgrown (record 30 inch tamarack bears N. $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 86 links). Tree destroyed by road construction (record 14 inch tamarack, S 87° E., 59 links).



DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Raised a collar of stone 2 foot base, 1 foot high around galvanized iron pipe and original corner stone, from which:

9 inch larch bears N. $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 17 links, scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 RM
