
1901, G.L.O. original record by Abram L. Jaqueth: Set a stone monument, marked a pine and tamarack for bearing trees.

1972, B.L.M. remonumentation record by Joseph E. French: "The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 32, as determined from the remains of the original bearing trees:

A larch stump, 10 ins. diam., bears $86\overset{4}{9}$ W, 64 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 \$32 BT. (Record: $858\overset{9}{9}$ W) A pine stump, 16 ins. diam., bears N58 $^{\circ}$ W, 21 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S29 BT. (Record: N64 $^{\circ}$ W)

At the corner point:

set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which new bearing trees:

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears 848° W, 32 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S32 BT. A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears $N83^{\circ}$ W, 13 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S29 BT.

Raise a flat mound of stone, 3 ft. base, arounmd the iron post."

A douglas fir, 11 ins. diam., bears $S48^{\circ}W$. 21.1 ft. (32 lks.) dist., scribe marks pitched over. (B.L.M. record)

A saw stump, 3 ft. high by 20 ins. diam., bears 866° W, 41.4 ft. (62.7 lks.) dist., mkd. S4 (G.L.O. record)


A saw stump, 3 ft. high by 11 ins. diam., bears N54°W, 13.6 ft. (20.6 lks.) dist., mkd. BT (G.L.O. record: N64 W, 21 lks.)

A douglas fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N80 $^{\circ}$ W, 8.5 ft. (12.9 lks.) dist., scribe marks pitched over.


III. Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, South, 3 ft.
