Found: A well set stone 3x8x18 ins. marked 6 HES 1241 on NE face & 3 HES 731 on NW face from which; A cedar, 26" dia., bears S40°46'E, 5 lks. dist. part of scribe is visible A cedar, 20" dia., bears N43°47'E, 22 lks. dist. part of X visible

Original record: A sandstone 3 x 8 x 9 ins. above ground, marked 6 HES 1241 on NE face from which A cross (x) on a cedar tree 12 ins. in dia. bears S40°46'E, 5 links dist.

A cross (x) on a cedar tree 6 ins. in dia. bears N43°47'E, 22 links dist., each blazed and scribed 6 H E S 1241 B T

Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high NE of corner
