
Corner MC Sec. 35 T. 33N R. 34W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1903 G.L.O. Record by Allen B. Benedict: Right bank of Kootenai River, set a granite stone, 18x12x10 ins., 6 ins. in the ground, for meandor cor. of fractional sec. 35, mkd. "M.C." on West face, and "S.C." on the North Face.

Established two bearing trees:

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N47°E, 35 lks. dist., mkd "T33N R34W S35 MC BT". A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N36°W, 15 lks. dist., mkd "T33N R34W S35 MC BT".

- II. No evidence found of corner monument, the M.C. of secs. 35 and 5, as determined from the remains of one original bearing tree.
- III. At the corner point, set an aluminum rock cap, 3 1/4 ins. diam., 3 1/2 in. stem, with concrete grout in a rock ledge, cap mkd. as shown.

The original bearing tree:

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N47°E, 23.1 ft. dist., with visible marks. (GLO-record)

The new bearing tree:

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N01°E, 50.5 ft. dist., mkd. "T33N R34W S35 MC BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
