

# CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

## DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

FOUND: No evidence of corner monument.

RECORD: Falls on a limestone rock in place, 4 x 2 x 1 ft. above ground.  
I cut a cross (+) at exact corner point for 1/4 sec. corner,  
marked 1/4 on W. side.

FOUND: A 36" Ponderosa Pine with scribing & a pine lying on ground with  
bearing tree scribing.

RECORD: (From which) A pine, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 76° E., 78 lks. dist.,  
marked 1/4 S. 14 B.T.

A pine 32 ins. diam., bears S. 1° 30' W., 32 lks. dist., marked 1/4  
S. 15 B.T.

## DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

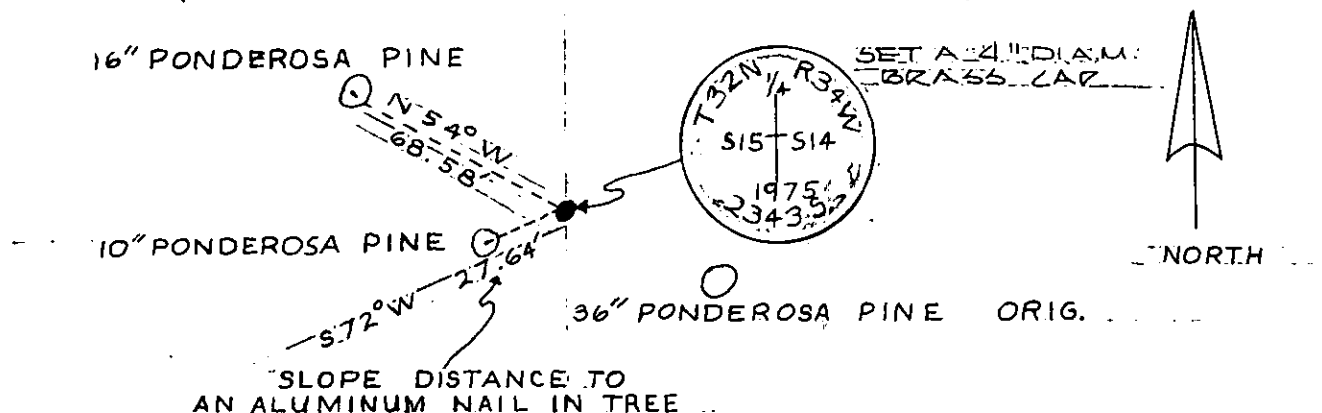

### REMONUMENTATION:

We measure original distances from 2 bearing trees and intersection  
point falls on rock in place.

At intersection point we set a 4" DIA. brass disk in rock and mark  
as per sketch below.

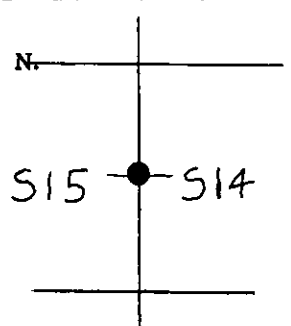
