

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

1/4 Cor. of Secs. 4 & 9 Lincoln Corner County

1903 G.L.O. record by Allen B. Benedict: Set a wood post monument and two bearing trees.

1968 B.L.M. remonumentation record by Woodrow E. Damn et al: "The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9. monumented with a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., firmly set, mkd. 1/4 on the N. face, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which:

The original bearing tree:

A pine, 36 ins. diam., bears N45°E, 20 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S4 BT. (Record)

A hemlock stump, 14 ins. diam., bears S23 1/2 E, 33 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S9 BT. (Record)

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears $838^{\circ}E$, 8 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S9 BT.. A larch, 7 ins. diam., bears $838^{\circ}E$, 8 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S4 BT.

Bury the original stone alongside the iron post."

II. Found a 2 1/2 ins. diam. iron pipe, 6 ins. above the ground with 3 1/4 ins. diam. B.L.M. brass cap. marked as shown above; from which:


Rotten remains of a pine, bears N45°E, 13.2 ft. (20 lks.) dist. Rotten remains of a hemlock, bears S24°E, 21.8 ft. (33 lks.) dist. A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S38°E, 5.1 ft. (8 lks.) dist., mkd. 1/4 S9 BT. (Record: fir) A larch, 9 ins. diam., bears N75°W, 16.0 ft. (24 lks.) dist., visible scribe.

III. Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, West, 3 ft.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
