

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

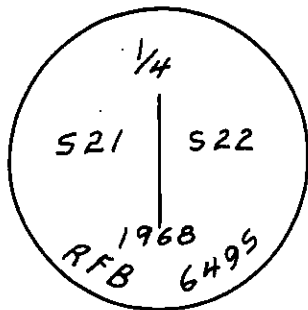

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found underground remains of post from which a 5' high by 10" diameter Cedar stump bears the record N 4°30'W, 20 links. At the record N 31°30' E, 12 links, the underground remains of a fir stump was found.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: 3-21-1968



Set a 2" x 30" pipe two feet deep with brass cap in exact position of original stake. Brass cap stamped as shown, from which: A Cedar stump, 5' high by 22" diameter, bears S 23° W, 19 links, scribed STR - RP. No other suitable trees or objects within reasonable distance.
