1976 Record:

Set a 1-1/2 ins. x 30 ins. brass capped pipe, 24 ins. in the ground from which:

A Douglas fir, 8 ins. dia., bears N35°E, 9.0 ft., scribed "RM1" A Grand fir, 16 ins. dia., bears S63°E, 36.2 ft., scribed "RM2"

2010 Found:

We find a 2-1/2 ins. dia. brass cap on 1-1/2 ins. dia. metal pipe, set firm, marked as shown below from which:

A fir, 13 ins. dia., bears N34°E, 9.0 ft., with an overgrown heel blaze.

2010 Perpetuation:

Establish new bearing tree as follows:


A fir, 15 ins. dia., bears N75°W, 28.2 ft., scribed "1/64 S14 RM"

Bearing trees affixed with BT tags, LSM signs, snow blazed and painted red bands.

Metal spike driven into BT's side center at point of measurement.

Set a galvanized steel post, N28°E, 1.2 ft from the monument with LSM and USFS boundary decals.

Note: Marking on cap differ from that of record.
