Set a 1-1/2 ins. x 30 ins. brass capped pipe, 24 ins. in the ground from which:

A Douglas fir, 18 ins. dia., bears N50°E, 20.0 ft., scribed "RM1" A Douglas fir, 12 ins. dia., bears S57°E, 24.2 ft., scribed "RM2"

2010 Found:

Found a 2-1/2 ins. dia. brass cap on 1-1/2 ins. dia. metal pipe set firm, marked as shown below from which:

An uprooted fir stump, 19 ins. dia., bears N50°E, 20.2 ft., with an overgrown heel blaze. Dimensions taken to a stump cavity in ground.

A fir stump, 14 ins. dia., bears S58°E, 23.5 ft., with no visible markings.

2010 Perpetuation:


Establish new bearing trees as follows:

A fir, 7 ins. dia., bears N40°E, 9.4 ft., scribed "CN 1/16 S14 RM1" A fir, 10 ins. dia., bears N28°W, 16.2 ft., marked "CN 1/16 S14 RM2"

Bearing trees affixed with BT tags, LSM signs, snow blazed and painted red bands.

Metal spike driven into BT's side center at point of measurement.

Set a galvanized steel post East, 2.0 ft from the monument with LSM and USFS boundary decals.
