GLO Record: Set limestone and established 2 bearing trees.

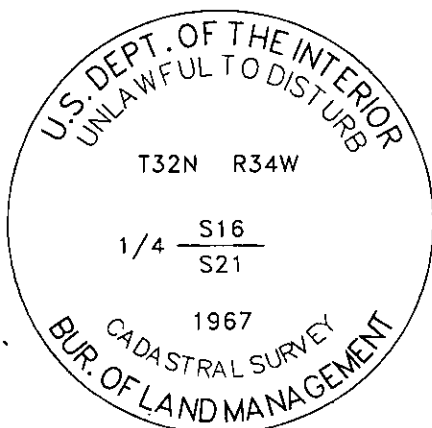
1967 BLM Record: Found original stone, firmly set and the remains of the SE bearing tree.  
Set 30 ins. x 2-1/2 ins. dia. iron post, 24 ins. in the ground, w/ brass cap. Set original stone alongside.  
From which:  
Original BT is fir stump, 14 ins. dia., bears S52°E, 20 lks (13.2 ft.), mkd "1/4 21 BT"  
Larch, 8 ins. dia., bears N52°30'E, 38 lks (25.1 ft.), mkd "1/4 S16 BT"  
Pine, 7 ins. dia., bears S42°30'W, 14 lks (9.2 ft.), mkd "1/4 S21 BT"

1982 Record: Found 2-1/2 ins. dia. BLM brass cap, 6 ins. out of the ground.  
(Hill 5612 S) From which:  
Larch, 11 ins. dia., bears N52°E, 25.1 ft., w/ visible scribing  
Ponderosa Pine, 10 ins. dia., bears S41°30'W, 9.3 ft., w/ visible scribing

1995 Record: 2-1/2 ins. dia. iron pipe, 4 ins. above the ground, firmly set, w/ 3-1/4 ins. dia. BLM brass cap.  
(Hughes 7322LS) From which:  
Rotten remains of fir, bears S52°E, 13.0 ft.  
Larch, 12 ins. dia., bears N52°E, 25.0 ft., w/healed face  
Pine, 13 ins. dia., bears S42°W, 9.2 ft., w/healed face

2010 Found: We find a 3-1/4 ins. dia. brass cap on 2-1/2 ins. dia. steel pipe, marked as shown below, rising 0.4 ft. out of ground. From which:  
Larch, 13 ins. dia., bears N53°30'E, 24.8 ft., w/overgrown blaze & BT tag  
Ponderosa Pine, 18 ins. dia., bears S41°W, 9.3 ft., w/overgrown blaze & BT tag

2010 Perpetuation: We establish no new reference monuments.  
We set a galvanized steel post, West, 0.8 ft. from the monument w/ LSM and USFS boundary decals.  
Bearing trees were affixed with BT tags and a painted red band.
