GLO Record: Set pine post and established 4 bearing trees.

1982 Record: Found no evidence of original pine post or S20 bearing tree.  
(Hill 5612S) Larch, 26 ins. dia., bears N36°E, 59.4 ft., visible scribing "S17 BT"  
Larch, 30 ins. dia., bears N64°30'W, 38.2 ft., visible scribing "S18 BT"  
Rotted stump (S19 BT)

Determined the corner position from the found BT's. Set a 2-1/2 ins. dia. x 30 ins. alum. pipe, 24 ins. in the ground w/ a collar of stone and an alum. cap.

Established new bearing trees:

Cedar, 11 ins. dia., bears S48°W, 9.4 ft., mkd "S19 BT"  
Larch, 11 ins. dia., bears S37°E, 20.0 ft., mkd "S20 BT"

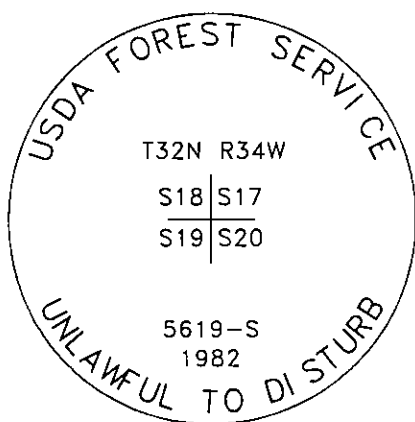
2010 Found: We find a 3-1/4 ins. dia. alum. cap, as shown below, on 2-1/2" dia. pipe, set flush w/ a mound of stone, from which:

Larch, dead fall, 26 ins. dia., bears N37°E, 59.6 ft., visible scribing "S" & blaze  
Cedar, 12 ins. dia., bears S41°W, 8.9 ft., scribed "S19 BT"  
Larch snag, 30 ins. dia., bears N63°W, 37.8 ft., visible scribing "S18" & blaze  
Larch, blown down, 13 ins. dia., bears S42°E, 20.0 ft., no visible scribing, BT tag, snow blaze

2010 Perpetuation: We establish new reference monuments as follows:  
Hemlock, 10 ins. dia., bears N35°30'E, 28.1 ft., scribed "T32N R34W S17 BT"  
Cedar, 6 ins. dia., bears S72°E, 12.8 ft., scribed "T32N R34W S20 BT"  
White Pine, 17 ins. dia., bears N43°W, 25.3 ft., scribed "T32N R34W S18 BT"

We set galvanized steel posts, West, 1.4 ft. and East, 1.4 ft. from the monument w/ LSM and USFS boundary decals.

Bearing trees were affixed with BT tags, snow blazed, and a painted red band.
