CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner: Section Corner; Secs. 13,14,23,24

T.32N. R. 34W. P.M.M. Lincoln County

1968 BLM Record:

The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, monumented with a limestone, 18 ins. x 10 ins. x 6 ins., firmly set, mkd. with 1 notch on the East and 3 notches on the South edges, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2-1/2 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground, with a brass cap from which the original bearing trees:

A snag, 12 ins. dia., bears S62°E, 11 lks (7.3 ft.), marked "T32NR34WS24BT". A stump hole, bears N22°45'W, 25 lks (16.5 ft.), marked "T32NR34WS14BT".

The new bearing trees:

A Cedar, 10 ins. dia., bears N34"45'E, 68 lks (44.9 ft.), marked "T32NR34WS13BT". A Cedar, 9 ins. dia., bears \$25°45'E, 37 lks (24.4 ft.), marked "T32NR34W\$24BT". A pine, 14 ins. dia., bears \$18°W, 81 lks (53.5 ft.), marked "T32NR34W\$23BT". A Cedar, 7 ins. dia., bears N44°30'W, 13 lks (8.6 ft.), marked "T32NR34WS14BT".

Bury the original stone alongside post.

2010 Found:

We find a 3-1/4 ins. brass cap on a 2-1/2 ins. dia. alum. shaft rising 8 ins. out of ground, marked as shown below from which:

A Cedar stump, 14 ins. dia., bears N34°30'E, 45.0 ft., with the scribing "S13BT"

A Larch snag, 10 ins. dia., bears S59°E, 7.7 ft., scribed "2N 34WS24BT" A Cedar, 12 ins. dia., bears S26°E, 24.3 ft., scribed "T32NR34 S24BT"

A rotted stump, bears \$18°W, 53.4 ft., no visible markings.


2010 Perpetuation:

Establish new bearing trees as follows:

A Hemlock, 10 ins. dia., bears N23°30'E, 16.3 ft., scribed "T32NR34WS13BT" A Cedar, 11 ins. dia., bears S52°30'W, 13.7 ft., scribed "T32NR34WS23BT" A Larch, 6 ins. dia., bears N56°W, 15.6 ft., scribed "T32NR34WS14BT"

Bearing trees affixed with BT tags, LSM signs, snow blazed and painted red bands. Steel spikes driven into BT's, side center at point of measurement.

We set galvanized steel posts, North, 12 ins. and West 14 ins. from monument, with LSM and USFS boundary decals.
