Found original stone lying loose on top of the ground. No evidence of original bearing trees was found. At determined proportional position, set a 2-1/2 ins. dia. x 30 ins. alum. pipe, 24 ins. in the ground w/ an alum. cap., in a collar of stone. Buried original stone alongside. (NOTE: SEE COS 1083)

Hemlock, 12 ins. dia., bears N44°W, 28.0 ft., mkd "1/4 S7 BT"

Spruce, 9 ins. dia., bears S56°E, 11.0 ft., mkd "1/4 S12 BT"

Douglas fir, 4 ins. dia., bears S24°W, 13.5 ft., attached location poster

1994 Record:
(Davis 4975 S)

Found 2-1/2 ins. dia. alum pipe w/ 3-1/4 ins. dia. alum. cap, firmly set 6 ins. above the ground.

From which:

Hemlock stump, 2 ft. high, 13-1/2 ins. dia., bears N44°W, 26.5 ft., scribed "1/4 S12 BT"

Sub Alpine Fir, 11 ins. dia., bears S56°E, 11.2 ft., scribed "1/4 S7 BT"

Douglas fir, 5-1/2 ins. dia., bears S24°W, 13.3 ft., w/ location poster

Established new bearing tree:

Douglas Fir, 5-1/2 ins. dia., bears S23°W, 13.3 ft., scribed "1/4 S12 BT"

Set a galvanized steel post, North, 2.0 ft., of the monument w/ LSM, USFS and property boundary decals

2010 Found:

We find a 3-1/4 ins. dia. alum. cap, marked as shown below, on a 2-1/2 ins. dia. alum. pipe, rising 0.5 ft. from the ground.

From which:

Sub Alpine Fir stump, 11-1/2 ins. dia., bears S56°E, 11.2 ft., scribed "1/4 S7 BT"

Douglas Fir, 7 ins. dia., bears S23°W, 13.3 ft., scribed "1/4 S12 BT"

Decaying stump, bears N44°W, 26.5 ft., w/ no visible scribing

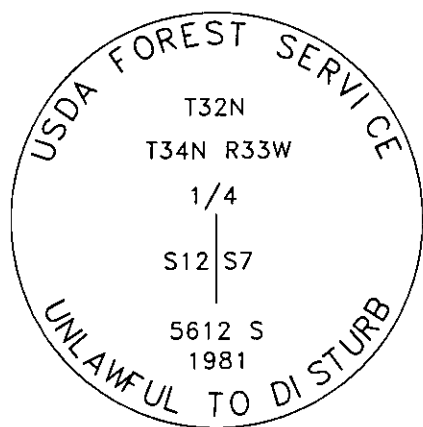
Galvanized steel post, bears North, 1.7 ft.
