

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

FOUND: A stone 18 x 8 x 5, 6" out of ground with 4 hash marks on South and 2 on East.

RECORD: Set a limestone 18 x 9 x 5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground....marked with 4 notches on S., and 2 notches on E. edge.

FOUND: 18" Douglas Fir scribed bearing tree at N26°W, 52.1'.
 12" Douglas Fir scribed bearing tree at N68°E, 11'.
 36" Ponderosa Pine scribed bearing tree at S56°E, 56.5'.
 20" Douglas Fir scribed bearing tree at S8°W, 44' (OVER)

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: DEC. 3, 1975

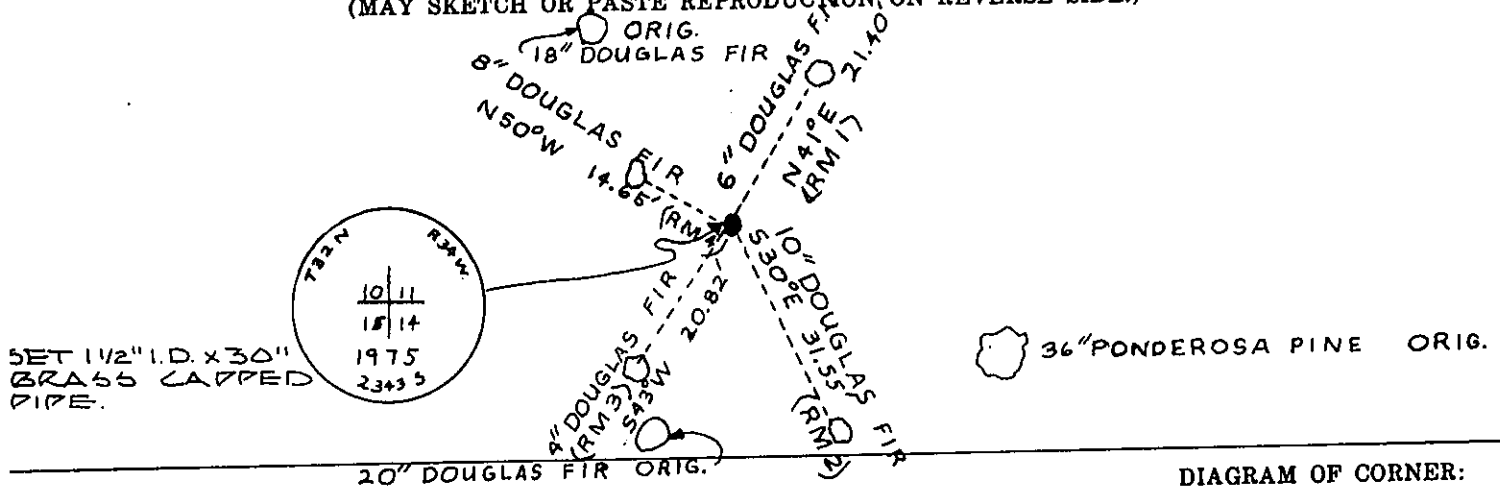
CORNER LOCATED USING RECORD DISTANCES FROM BEARING TREES.

We set a 1 1/2" x 30" gal. pipe with brass cap 24" in ground and buried original stone on West side. Brass cap is stamped as per sketch. We built a cairn of rocks around pipe.

We make new reference monuments as per sketch and tag and paint same.

Measurements are to center of tree.

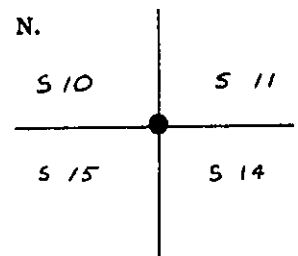
