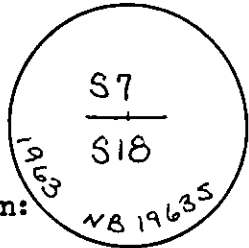

Collar of stone.

From which: A 12" douglas fir bears S48°E., 24.7 ft. Scribing visible, alive and well.
A 10" pine bears West, 23.6 ft. Healed face, alive and well.

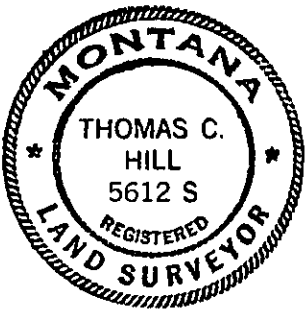

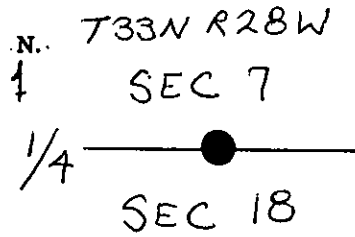
