III. Perpetuation: At the corner point, determined by survey, set a 5/8 ins. diam. steel rebar 24 ins. long, 22 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 ins. diam. U.S.D.A Aluminum cap marked as shown below from which:

A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 63°E., 7.40 ft. dist., scribed X WC BT.

A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 52°30'W., 7.10 ft. dist., scribed X WC BT.

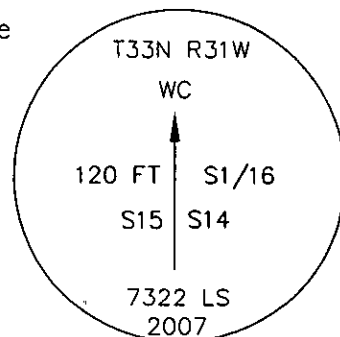
Painted faces and 6 in. wide red bands to all bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Raise a collar of stone, 1 ft. base 1 ft. high around set monument.

Set a steel post on line 2 ft. North of set monument with attached Land Survey Monument and Property Boundary stickers.

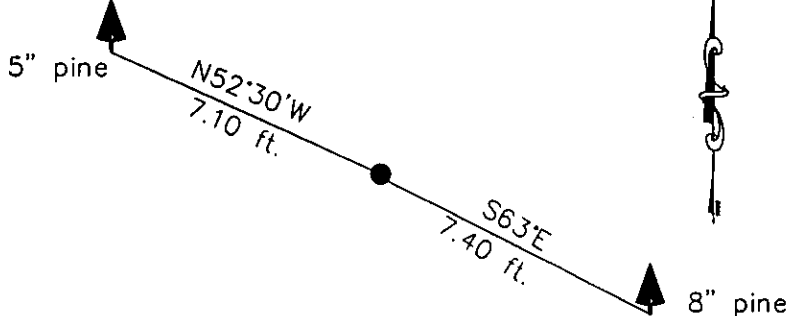

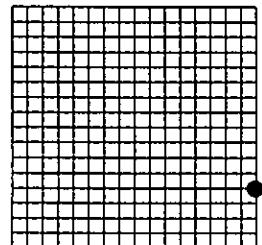
