
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner S 1/4 Sec. 31 T. 33N R. 31W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1904 G.L.O. Original Record by Ranney Y. Lyman et. al: Set a limestone, 14x12x5 ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for standard 1/4 sec. cor., mkd. "SC 1/4" on the N. face. Established two bearing trees.

1976 B.L.M. Remonumentation Record by Joseph E. French: The Standard 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 31 on the S. boundary of the Township, monumented with a limestone, 14x12x5 ins., firmly set, 9 ins. in the ground, mkd. "SC 1/4" on the N. face, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. as shown.



Established two new bearing trees and buried the original stone alongside and raise a flat mound of stone, 2.0 ft. diam., around the iron post.


II. Found a brass cap, protruding 5 ins. above the ground, firmly set, with a small rock collar, mkd. as shown above. Found the GLO and BLM bearing trees.

from which:

A rotted stump, bears N17°E, 16.5 ft. dist., "4 S31 SC" visible. (G.L.O.-record)
A pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S83°E, 34.98 ft. dist., with a pirtched over face. (B.L.M.-record)
A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears N13°W, 34.32 ft. dist., "1/4 S31 BT" visible. (B.L.M.-record)
A down tree, bears N33°W, 13.2 ft. dist., "SC 1/4 S31 BT" visible. (G.L.O.-record)

III. Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.



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
