

I. 1899 U.S. Geological Survey by D. L. Reaburn, U.S. Surveyor: Set an iron post, 6 ft. long, 4 in. diam., 3 ft. in the ground and deposited charcoal underneather the poost. The post is surrounded by a bronze cap which is stamped as shown. Dug pits 3x2x1 1/2 ft. in diam., 4.0 ft. North and South and built mounds of earth, 4.0 ft. East and West of the post.

Established three bearing trees:

A pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N76°E, 56.0 ft. dist., mkd "Mont. P. 38 BT". A pine, 24 ins. diam., bears S45°30'E, 29.0 ft. dist., mkd "Mont. P. 38 BT". A fir. 15 ins. diam., bears N88°20'W, 50.0 ft. dist., mkd "Idaho P. 38 BT".



II. Found a 3 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, protruding 3 ft. above ground, with a 3 3/4 in. diam. U.S.G.S. brass cap mkd. as shown.

from which:

A pine stump, 28 ins. diam., bears N76°E, 56.0 ft. dist., no visible scribe. (record) A rotten fir stump, bears N88°W, 50.0 ft. dist., no visible scribe. (record) Pits, North and South, 4.0 ft. dist. of the monument. Mounds, East and West, 4.0 ft. dist. of the monument.

III. Established two new bearing trees:

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N65°E, 55.4 ft. dist., mkd. "MONT P 38 BT". A fir, 13 ins. diam, bears N17°W, 44.1 ft. dist., mkd. "IDAHO P 38 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
