I. 1912 G.L.O. Record by William C. Perkins: Set a slate stone, 18x10x10 ins. 14 ins. in the ground, for witness corner to the secs and meander cor., mkd. "WCMC" on N.E. face, with 2 notches on the S. and 4 notches on the E. edge.

Established two bearing trees:


A tamarack, 5 ins. diam., bears S74°W, 92 lks. dist., mkd "WCMC T33N R34W S29 BT". A willow, 6 ins. diam., bears N36°W, 4 lks. dist., mkd "WCMC T33N R34W S20 BT".

II. No evidence of original stone, found one bearing tree.

from which:

A larch stump, 8 ins. diam., bears S74°W, 60.7 ft. dist., with visible scribe. (G.L.O.-record)

III. At the corner position, as determined by using record bearing and distance, from the found bearing tree, set a 2 1/2 in. diam. aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. above a rock collar, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap, mkd. as shown.



Established two new bearing trees:

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S42°W, 26.9 ft. dist., mkd. "WCMC T33N R34W S29 BT". A larch, 6 ins. diam., bears N85°W, 28.1 ft. dist., mkd. "WCMC T33N R34W S20 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
