At the point of intersection, I set a granite stone, 16x16x6 ins., 11 ins. in the ground for the closing cor. of secs. 20 and 29, mkd. "CC" on E. face, with 2 grooves on S. and 4 grooves on N. face.

Established two bearing trees:



II. Found stone, 13x12 ins., protruding 8 ins. above the ground, mkd. with 4 notches on N. face, 2 notches on S. face, "CC" on N.E. face.

A rotten fir stump, bears N20°E, 56.1 ft. dist., no visible scribe. (record) A rotten fir stump, bears S88°E, 20.5 ft. dist., with visible scribe. (record)

III. At the exact corner position, as determined by the found original stone and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees, set a 2 1/2 in. diam. aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap, mkd. as shown.



Established two new bearing trees:

A hemlock, 11 ins. diam., bears N48°E, 26.3 ft. dist., mkd. "T33N R34W CC S20 BT". A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S22°E, 35.3 ft. dist., mkd. "T33N R34W CC S29 BT".

Bury the original stone alongside the aluminum pipe.
