




At the corner position as determined by survey, set a 5/8"x 30" rebar, with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " aluminum cap marked as shown: 3)

13" Larch bears S33°W, 2.8' distant, scribed C E SW SE1/256 S17 BT. 6" Grand Fir bears S64°E, 24.3' distant, scribed C E SW SE1/256 S17 BT. A 13" Larch

Monument was set 0.2' above grade. A 6' steel post with Land Survey Monument and Forest Service Property Boundary decals attached was placed 0.9' north of monument. Blazes and scribing on bearing trees were painted red. Bearing tree tags and Land Survey Monument signs were attached to trees.
