



The existing 10" Cedar bears N12°E, 44.6' distant. The existing 9" Douglas Fir bears S77°E, 55.2' distant.

The found Railroad spike bears  $S4^{\circ}W$ , 0.33' from aluminum cap. Corner is approximately 3.9' easterly of east edge of Highway 2, in an asphalt driveway turnout. Blazes and scribing on trees were painted red. Land Survey monument signs and Bearing tree tags were attached to trees.
