From Which:

A cross (X) on a Red Fir tree 9 inches diameter Bears N 37° 42" E., 21 LKS distance.

A cross (X) on a Yellow Pine 14 inches diameter Bears S 37° 57" W., 51 LKS distance each blazed and scribed 1/ 256 6 HES 898 BT.

Raise a mound of earth 4 ft base 2 ft high SW of corner.

## Found Evidence:

Original stone with mound of stones SW of corner and remains of original fir NE of corner scribing legible but fallen over.

Perpetuation:

Established two bearing trees for corner #6.


