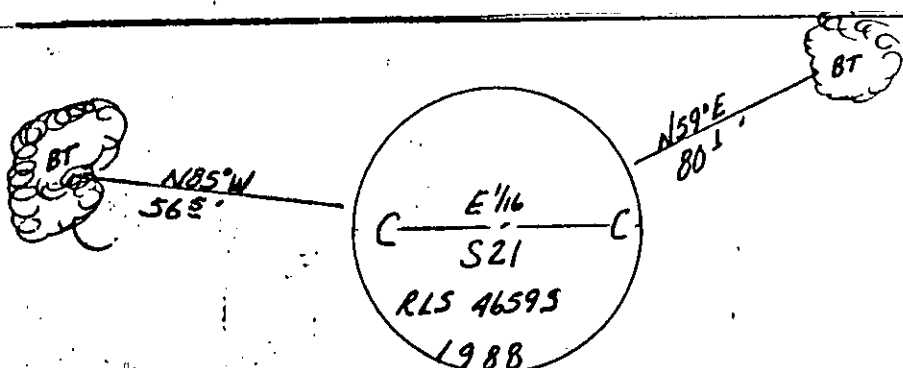
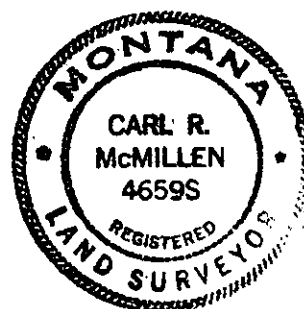
The new corner monument was established as a result of a subdivisional survey of Section 21, T33N, R34W, P.M.M. Said subdivisional survey was made in accordance with methods and procedures contained in the 1973 B.L.M. Manual of Surveying Instructions. See filed certificate of survey at the Lincoln County Courthouse.

Set a 3/4" X 30" aluminum shaft with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap, 27" in the ground, marked as shown below, from which:

- An 8" cedar bears N59 E, 80.1 feet, marked "CE 1/16 S21 BT".
- A 9" cedar bears N85 W, 56.5 feet, marked "CE 1/16 S21 BT".

I. painted the blazes red and painted a 6" band of red paint around each bearing tree.

Bearing tree tags were attached to the front of each bearing tree and Land Monument signs attached to the back. I also set a steel fencepost 6 feet east of the monument and attached "Property Boundary" and "Land Survey Monument" decals.
