

- INSTRUCTIONS
1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
  2. Description of monument found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of checking test or substituted corner.
  3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
  4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
  5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
  6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

## CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner CW 1/16 S 21 T. 33N R. 3W P.M.M. Lincoln County

**RECORD:** The original G.L.O. survey was conducted by Allen R. Benedict in 1905.

The monument was set during Exchange Survey No. 1258 as conducted by Donald Sawhill in 1942.....

Set an iron post, 3 feet long and 2 inches in diameter, 26 inches in the ground, with broken glass deposited at the base, with brass cap stamped "17 ES 1258 CW 1/16 S21 1941", from which:

A cross on an 8" white fir bears N57 50'W, 45 links (29.70 feet), marked "1/16S 17 ES 1258 BT".

A cross on a 10" douglas fir bears N41 45'E, 35 links (23.10 feet), marked "1/16S 17 ES 1258 BT".

**FOUND:** Found the brass cap and iron pipe flush with the ground marked as shown below. No evidence of original BT's found.

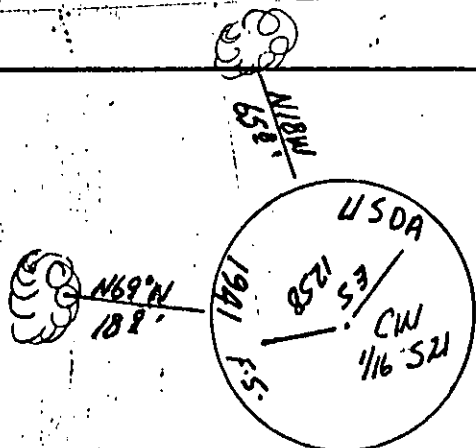
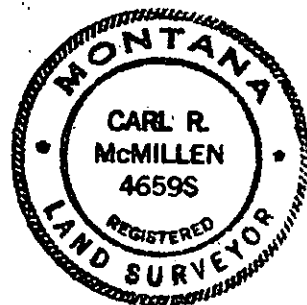
**MAINTENANCE:** Established 2 new bearing trees.

A 7 1/2" cedar bears N69 W, 18.9 feet, marked "CW 1/16 S21 BT"

A 6" hemlock bears N18 W, 65.8 feet, marked "CW 1/16 S21 BT"

The blazes were painted red and a 6" band was painted around each bearing tree.

Bearing tree tags were attached to the front of each bearing tree. A Land Monument sign was nailed to the back of the cedar bearing tree and an Attention sign was nailed to the back of the hemlock bearing tree.
