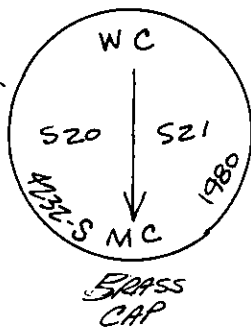
DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found B.T.: 14" Juniper marked T33N, R34W, S20, M.C.B.T. No evidence of Scribe on Stone.  
Original Record: 5" Alder Bears S56°30'E, 44 LKS, T33N, R34W, S21, M.C.B.T.  
10" Cedar Bears S01°W, 16 LKS, T33N, R34W, S20, M.C.B.T. Cut X on ledge of rock 5' high, marked M.C. on South Side 4 grooves on East Side.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

I set a 2" inch pipe with 2 1/2" Brass Cap marked as shown on sketch. I made 2 Bearing Trees: A 13" Doug Fir Bears S38°37'E 26.9' and a 9" Doug Fir Bears S49°15'W 18.30'. The distances were measured from the Brass cap to the tap roots breast high {slope}. See reverse for sketch and markings.

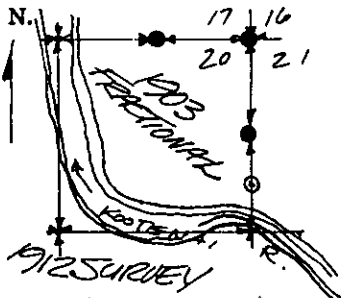
