DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

ORIGINAL G.L.O. NOTES: "To a point for 1/64 sec. cor. of sec. 11, heretofore located upon the ground, identical with listing corner No. 14, marked and witnessed as described by the District Forster. I destroy the listing corner and its accessories, and in its place establish 1/64 cor of Sec. 11 and Cor. No. 11 of this survey as follows:

Place a small stone marked with a cross (x) under a quartzite stone 24 x 24 x 8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, marked 11 HES 1238 on the SW., and 1/64 S.11 on the N. faces, and with a cross (x) on the top for the exact corner point, from which

A cross (x) on a Douglas fir tree 8 ins. dia. bears S.75°15'W., 54 lks. dist.,

A cross (x) on a spruce tree 7 ins. dia. bears N. 7°15'E., 26 lks. dist., each blazed and scribed 11 HES 1238 BT."

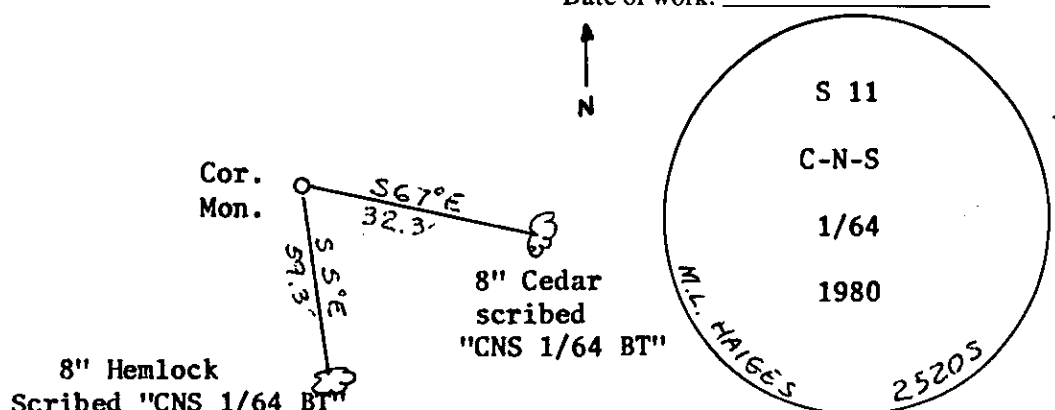
