ORIGINAL G.L.O. NOTES: "To approximate point for 1/256 sec. cor., identical with listing corner No. 9, marked and witnessed as described by the District Forester. I destroy the listing corner and its accessories and in its place establish Cor. No. 6 of this survey as follows:

Place a small stone marked with a cross (x) under an iron post 36 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with a brass cap marked 6 HES 1238 in the SW. sector, 1927 in the S. segment, and with a point on top for the exact corner point, from which

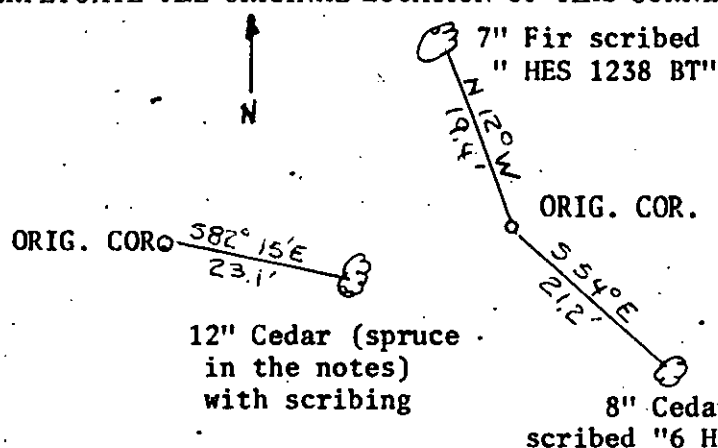
A cross (x) on a spruce tree 7 ins. dia. bears S. 10°00' E., 44 lks. dist.,

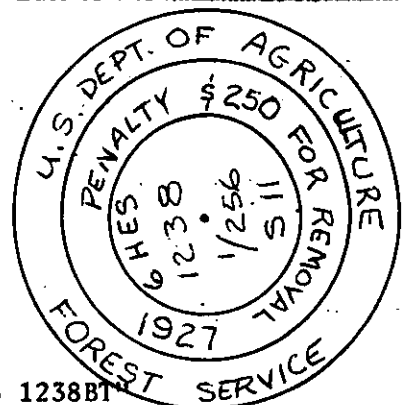
