

- I. 1981 Certified Corner Recordation by Jack H. Ninneman, Registration No. 4661S: Set by survey, a 5/8 in. diam. x 24 ins. long, capped steel pin, stamped "J.H.N. 4661S". Established two bearing trees.
- II. Found a 5/8 in. diam. rebar, firmly set, protruding 2 ins. above the ground, with a yellow plastic cap, mkd. "4661S".

from which:

A larch, 13 ins. diam., bears N52°E, 15.9 ft. dist., with a healed face. (1981-record-N46°E) A larch, 15 ins. diam., bears S52°W, 23.1 ft. dist., with a healed face. (1981-record)

III. Accepted the position of the found rebar, set in its place, an aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap, mkd. as shown below.




Buried the found rebar inside the aluminum pipe.

Set a 6 ft. steel guard post, West, on property line, 3.0 ft. dist. from the corner, with Land Survey Monument and Property Boundary decals attached.
