
## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

Corner 1/4 Sec. 9&16 T. 33N R. 34W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. <u>1903 G.L.O. Original record by Allen B. Benedict:</u> Set a limestone, 24x10x3 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. mkd. "1/4" on the N. face. jEstablished two bearing trees.

1966 B.L.M. Remonumentation record by Joseph E. French et. al: The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 9 and 16, as determined from the remains of the original bearing trees. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with the brass cap mkd. as shown:



Established two new bearing trees:

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S76 1/2°W, 271 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S16 BT".

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N50 1/2°W, 63 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S9 BT".

II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, firmly set, protruding 6 ins. above the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam.B.L.M. brass cap, mkd. as shown above.

from which:

A stump, 16 ins. diam., bears S50°E, 22.7 ft. dist., mkd. "1/4 S16 BT". (GLO-record-S52°E) A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears N43°W, 42.3 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM-record-N50 1/2°W)


III. Established one new bearing tree:

A larch, 12 ins. diam., bears S52°W, 138.4 ft. dist., mkd. "1/4 S16 BT".


Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
